

Disclaimer for the use of “estimates”: sources used on the night of the European elections 2019 (26 May 2019 from 18:00 CET TIME)

On the night of the European elections, Kantar will project the seats of the next European Parliament.

As from 18.00 CET, Kantar will publish seat projections in the form of ‘national estimates’ for Member States where voting has closed. Data for these ‘national estimates’ will come from publicly available sources such as exit polls or ‘estimations’ (in France, Malta and Austria). In this case, the label “estimate” will accompany the data and chart. These ‘national estimates’ will be the only available national data before the publication of official results starts at 23.00 CET.

The following table sets out the list of sources Kantar will use to calculate the seats obtained per party and European political group at a national level and in the global EP projection. As soon as provisional or final results are published by the responsible national election authorities, they will replace the national estimates listed below:
